



Year 1 Curriculum Map - Autumn Term 2024 - Palm Class

Maths



This term Year 1 are learning about pattern, shape, and sorting groups. We will also be learning how to order and represent numbers in lots of different ways. We will be learning to count on from any given number and recall number facts such as 1 more and 1 less.

English

In English, we are learning to compose and write sentences which can be read by ourselves and others. We need to remember to use: capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will begin by looking at some Traditional Tales such as Goldilocks and The Three Bears which we will use to develop our writing. We will then move on to other fiction and non-fiction books, which will inspire our independent writing.

Reading

This term we will be consolidating Phase 3 sounds and learning to blend and read words with these sounds in, including Phase 4 words. We will be applying our phonics and reading skills by reading simple sentences and answering questions about what we have read. We will also be learning to recognise and read new tricky words.

Science: Human Senses



This project teaches children that humans are a type of animal known as a mammal. They name and count body parts and identify similarities and differences. They learn about the senses, the body parts associated with each sense and their role in keeping us safe.

We have lots of exciting and interesting experiments which will allow the children to explore these senses.

History: Childhood History

In History we will exam the children's life history, and that of their families. We look forward to sharing baby photos! This project teaches children about everyday life and families today, including comparisons with childhood in the 1950s, using artefacts and a range of different sources.

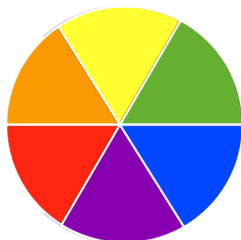
Geography: Our Wonderful World

In Geography, this topic teaches children about physical and human features, maps, cardinal compass points, and positional and directional language. They learn about the equator, hemispheres and continents and are introduced to the countries, capital cities and settlements of the United Kingdom. The children carry out simple fieldwork to find out about local physical and human features.



Art & Design: Colour Mixing

This project teaches children about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their artwork.



PSHE: Families and Friendships and Safe Relationships



Through our PSHE lessons this term we will continue to develop our understanding of family and friendships, who is special to us, who can help us and who we can talk to if we have any worries. This will then progress to safe relationships and how to show respect to ourselves and others.

In RWV the children will begin to learn what Christians believe God is like and exploring who made the world.
