Maths

We will be learning about place value of 3 and 4 digit numbers, addition and subtraction using 3-digit numbers and multiplication and division.

English



We will be using the texts Stone Age Boy and Jack & The Beanstalk. We will use Jack & The Beanstalk to help us look at writing our own sentences, focusing on the correct use of punctuation marks. This will then help us to write our own passages of text using subordination and coordination. We will also explore other great stories.

Religion and World Views (RWV)

In RWV, we will be exploring Hinduism and discovering how deities and key figures are described in Hindu sacred texts and stories. Then we will move on to Islam and learn about what the main concepts in Islam reveal about the nature of Allah to Muslims.



Science: Animal Nutrition and the Skeletal System



This project teaches children about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They learn about the role of a skeleton & muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton.

History: Through the Ages

This project teaches children about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.

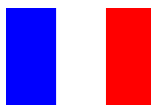
PSHE: Families & Friendships

Children will learn what makes a family and the features of family life, recognising and respecting that there are different types of families, including single parents, same-sex parents, step-parents, blended families, foster and adoptive parents. They will then learn about safe relationships and the importance of personal boundaries, how to safely respond to others and the impact of hurtful behaviour.



French

We will be learning how to greet each other in French, how to ask questions to find out about each other and how to talk about ourselves



PE

We will be learning Football and Netball skills, continuing to develop ball control. Our Football and Netball lessons will improve decision making in game situations, allowing children to make passes and move into good positions to make it difficult for opponents. Children are encouraged to work well with others, communicating and collaborating, whilst being fair and respectful when competing against others.



Music

We will be learning to understand that long and short sounds (rhythm) and high and low sounds (pitch) can be represented by musical symbols when we sing or play instruments.



DT: Cook Well, Eat Well

This project teaches children about food groups and the Eatwell guide. They learn about methods of cooking and explore these by cooking potatoes and ratatouille. The children choose and make a taco filling according to specific design criteria.



Geography: One Planet, Our World

This essential skills and knowledge project teaches children to locate countries and cities, and use grid references, compass points and latitude and longitude. They learn about the layers of the Earth and plate tectonics and discover the five major climate zones. They learn about significant places in the United Kingdom and carry out fieldwork to discover how land is used in the locality.
